

Freight Rail

Two railroad corridors service Clayton County providing industrial railway service north to the major rail hub of Atlanta and south to Macon. The Norfolk Southern Railway line extends approximately 6.5 miles across the northeast corner of the county. The Norfolk Southern Railway enters Clayton County in the north near Georgia Highway 42 and exits the county in the southeast near Big Cotton Indian Creek. The Norfolk Southern Railway line maintains the highest level of freight traffic in the county with 23 trains per day. The Central of Georgia Railroad, a subsidiary of Norfolk Southern Railway, enters Clayton County at the northern boundary near Interstate 75 and bisects the county for nearly 20 miles until it enters Henry County.
