**POST-MEETING SUMMARY  
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2021**

The special called meeting of the Development Authority of Clayton County, Redevelopment Authority of Clayton County, and Urban Redevelopment Agency of Clayton County was held on Tuesday, December 7, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., at 1588 Westwood Way, Morrow, Georgia.

Members present at the meeting were Regina Deloach, Chair; Herman Andrews, Vice-Chair; Mark Christmas, Assistant Secretary/Treasurer; Larry Vincent; Emma Godbee; Michelle Fuqua; Phong Duong; and John Lampl. Also present was Authority counsel, M. Michelle Youngblood.

**Call to Order and Welcome of Guests**

Chair Deloach called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and called on Mark Christmas for the invocation. She also called for a moment of silence to honor slain Clayton County Police Officer Henry Laxson. After a moment of silence, Mr. Christmas gave the invocation.

**Approval of Agenda**

Chair Deloach presented the agenda and inquired as to whether there were any additions, changes, or deletions. There being none, upon motion by Mark Christmas, seconded by John Lampl, the agenda was unanimously approved as presented.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**1. Consider Bond Resolution (Gilbert Road JV Project)**

Chair Deloach called on Authority counsel for a report. Authority counsel asked the members present to confirm that they had no conflict of interest with the pending project. After confirmation from each member present that there was no conflict, she presented the bond resolution for consideration. She reminded the Board that this project is for the development of approximately 88 acres in the Mountain View area, which will include 5 buildings totaling approximately 700,000 sf. The first occupant is expected to be a logistics company that will provide 100 new jobs in the first year, and an additional 20 jobs the next year. The entire development is projected to create approximately 1,500 new jobs. After a general discussion, upon

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motion by Herman Andrews, seconded by Mark Christmas, the bond resolution was approved; vote unanimous.
